

AESS Graduate Student Representative (GSR)

Conditions of Eligibility:

- 1) IEEE Graduate Student member in good standing
- 2) IEEE AES Society member during tenure
- 3) Endorsed by IEEE AESS member

Selection and Term of Office:

- 1) Nominations may be solicited from the current AESS Board of Governors (BoG), should the President choose to do so.
- 2) The President appoints the GSR for a 2-year term, renewable once, starting January 1 each year.

Requirements of Role:

- 1) Serve as a non-voting member on the AESS Board of Governors.
- 2) Collaborate with the Society's IEEE Young Professionals (YP) representative.
- 3) Actively seek feedback on the professional needs/aspirations of IEEE graduate student members.
- 4) Identify IEEE graduate students willing to support society activities and coordinate their efforts.
- 5) Motivate and lead graduate student members in organizing new/creative AESS-relevant activities.
- 6) Contribute to the implementation and promotion of the AESS mentoring scheme.
- 7) Make society information/news available to graduate student members and YP affinity groups.
- 8) Raise graduate student member awareness of IEEE OUs, programs, events, learning opportunities.
- 9) Sustain regular dialogue between AESS BoG and IEEE graduate student members.
- 10) Encourage graduate student members to influence and invigorate AESS chapter activities.
- 11) Report on AESS graduate student activities at each AESS BoG meeting.
- 12) Engage with both IEEE student member and YP activity leaders in TAB and MGA.
- 13) Apply guidance from the AESS Board of Governors and AESS Chapters Coordinator.

Expected Meeting Attendance:

- 1) Attend two IEEE AESS BoG meetings during the year, one in the spring and one in the fall.
- 2) Participate in online meetings and teleconferences, as needed.
