Affiliate privileges – i.e., what do they get for their \$3,000?

- Political and programming "access" to a larger group of membership and public impressions, <u>outside</u> their own society/OU - to bridge and build new relationships - leading to new products, services, and programming thereby afford-ably gaining new market exposure to fuel benefits and member retention/recruitment.
- Priority access to new TE programming and products for their membership



- The Affiliate Members will have subscription access for their members - free of any charge, to the TE eNewsletter. Whose EiC and contributing editors are experts in this space, and a recognized leader in the TE space
- An elected representative on the Steering Committee with vote (the Affiliates will elect their own representative – as outlined in Policy and Procedures for this major global growth area



- The Affiliates would gain access to communications, products, and services of the TE activities. This will give them an immense increase in marketing potential. And potentially, a large and influential outreach to any one constituency within the IEEE.
