### Description

To recognize an individual or team at any level who were industry employees whose technical contributions have resulted in significant advances in integrated electronic systems and large-scale integrated interoperable systems within the scope of the Society.

#### Prize

\$1,500 USD honorarium (up to a maximum of \$4,500 USD per award), a plaque, and certificate for each awardee. In the event that there are more than three awardees, the maximum prize shall be divided equally among all awardees.

### **Funding**

Funded by the IEEE Aerospace and Electronic Systems Society

#### Presentation

At a convenient IEEE AESS conference

### Eligibility

The award shall be open to individuals at any level who were industry employees and played a significant role in the technical contribution at the time of the accomplishments being recognized. The candidate does not have to be an IEEE/AESS member, but given everything else being equal, a member will be given preferential consideration. Current officers and members of the AESS Board of Governors are ineligible. Self-nominations are not accepted or considered.

### **IEEE AESS Early Industrial Innovation Award - Nomination Form**

To recognize an individual or team at any level who were industry employees whose technical contributions have resulted in significant advances in integrated electronic systems and large-scale integrated interoperable systems within the scope of the Society.

The award is open to individuals at any level who were industry employees and played a significant role in the technical contribution at the time of the accomplishments being recognized. Candidate need not be an IEEE AESS member.

Remember this is a technical achievement award, program management successes are recognized by the Management Society. There have been some challenges in recent years questioning if we had the "real" contributors, especially since successful "complex systems" tend to have many fathers. That's why the endorsement letters are so critical. They establish the validity of the individual(s) that are key, those that without them the success of the "system" would have been highly unlikely. It is not a condition that any awardees should have been sole or original inventor or developer, "significant contribution" of a specific nature is the key criterion

  - <u>Strengths</u>: What Has Been Accomplished <u>In Last 3 Years</u>
  - Proposed the IEEE AESS Distinguished Service Award (approved by the TABARC on March 21st, submitted to the Technical Activities Board for approval at its June 2022 meeting)
  - Note that this award will replace the existing IEEE AESS Organizational Leadership Award, i.e. the IEEE AESS Organizational Leadership Award will be dissolved with the approval of this new IEEE AESS Distinguished Service Award.

- Provide SWOT Planning For Awards Area
  - <u>Weaknesses</u>: Define Areas Of Growth (3 Years) Needed To Improve Services
  - For most of the awards, the number of nominations received every year is still small;
     sometimes only 1 (in this case we usually extend the deadline) or 2.
  - Opportunities: Define Quantified Plans And Collaborations Needed
  - The six AESS Panels should contribute more substantially, e.g. providing 1-2 nominations every year for each award (TBD with VP Technical Operations, Michael Braasch).
  - A collaboration has recently been initiated with the Industry Relations committee (chaired by the VP Industry Relations, Michael Noble) to stimulate more nominations of industry people for our awards, and in particular for the Industrial Innovation Award.
