6. Increase member participation in AESS activities and events, especially students and YPs.

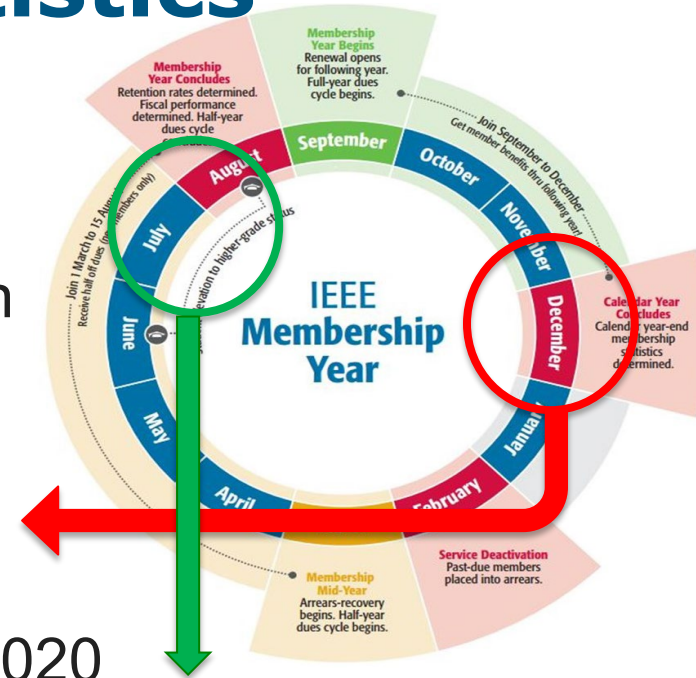
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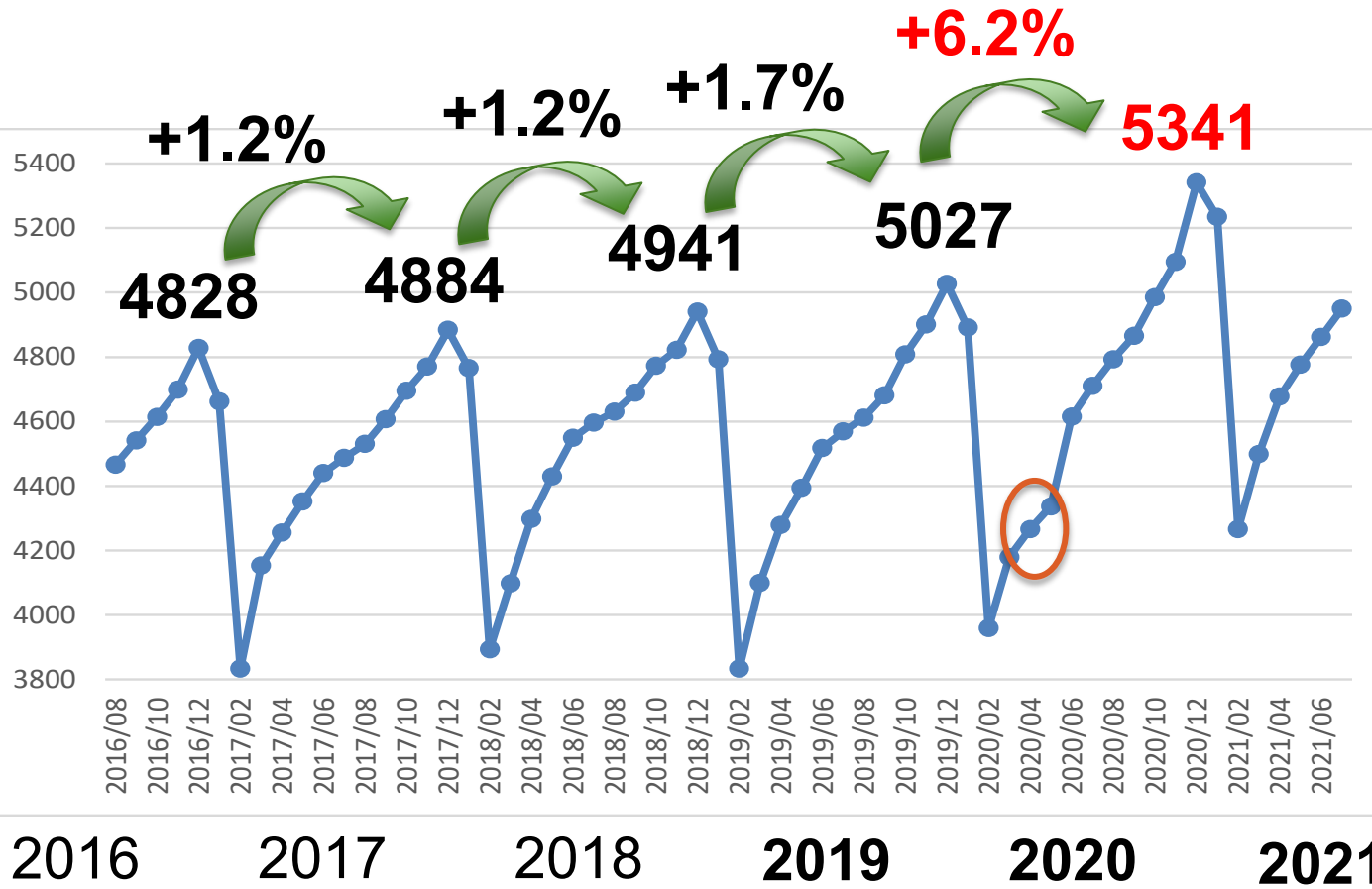
IEEE Membership statistics

- By the end of 2020, overall IEEE membership was **down 5.5%** or 23,000 members year-over-year, and more than **73% of these losses were students**.
- Society memberships were down 2238 (-0.7%) in 2020 compared to 2019.
- Currently on the path to recovery from 2020 pandemic losses: through July, IEEE membership is showing a **+1.9% growth** over last year.
- Society memberships are **up +5.1% YoY**, compared to 2020 month-end July, GSMs and Student members being major contributors via the Future50 Program.

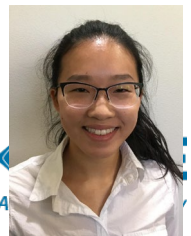


Mentoring Program

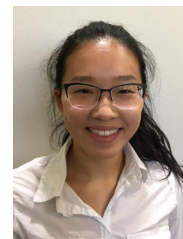

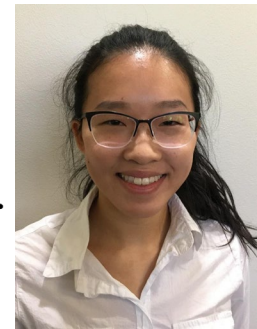
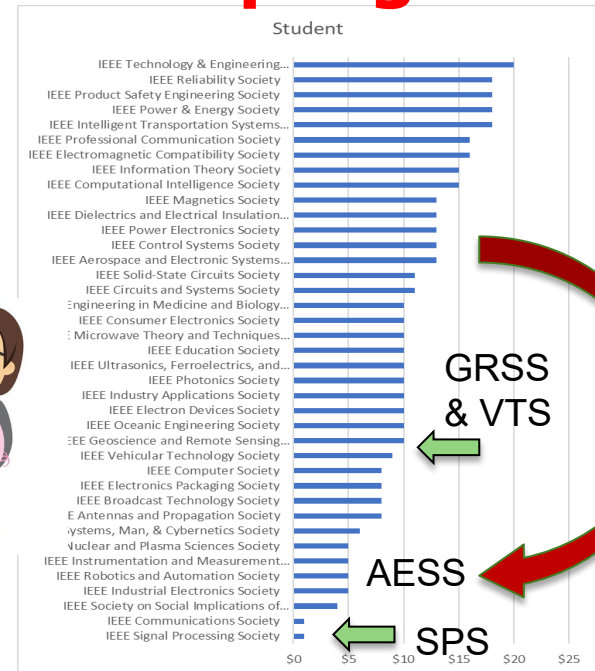
Student member fees reduced down to 5\$

- Change become effective in 2021.



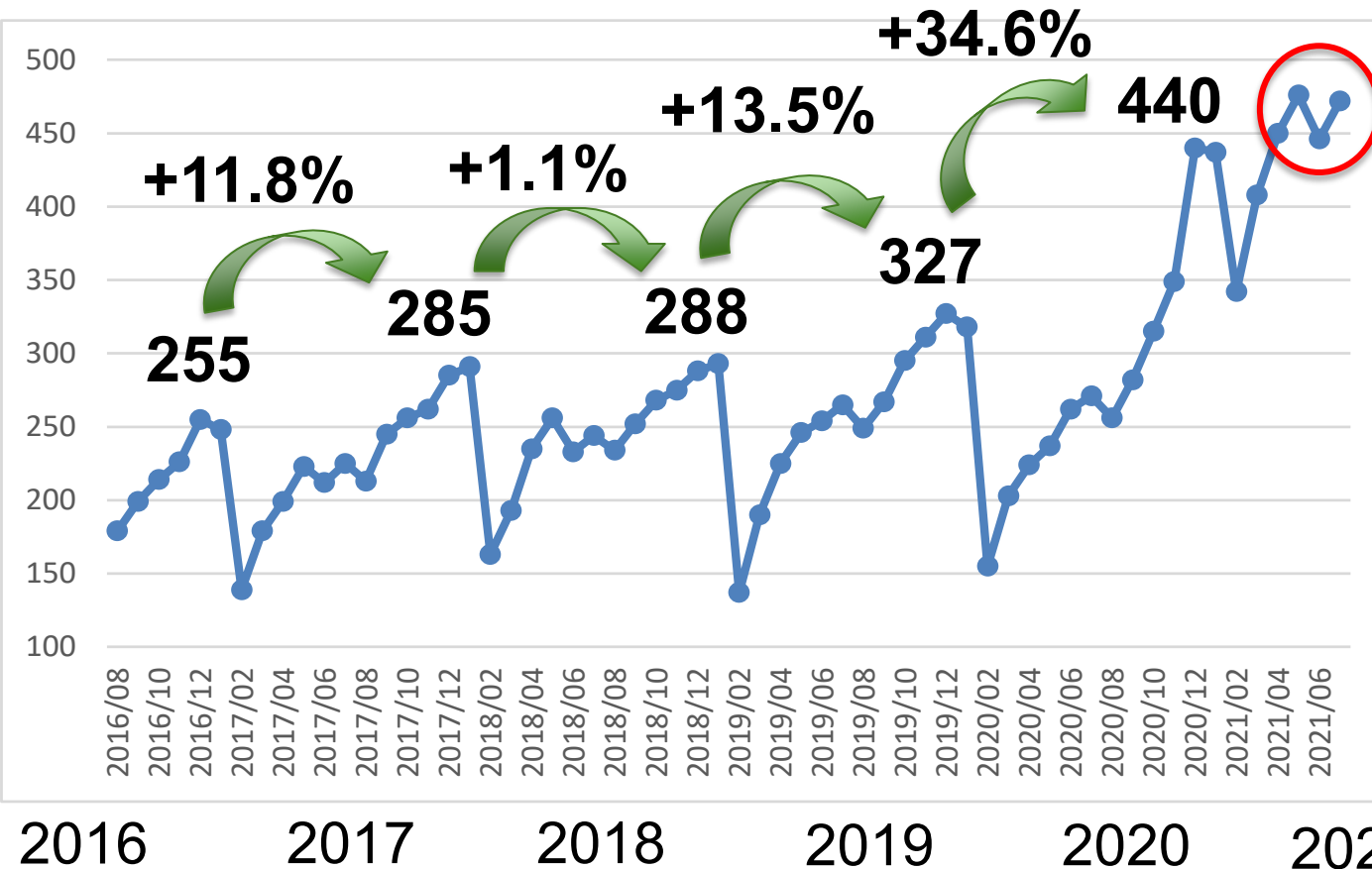
Customized membership bundles

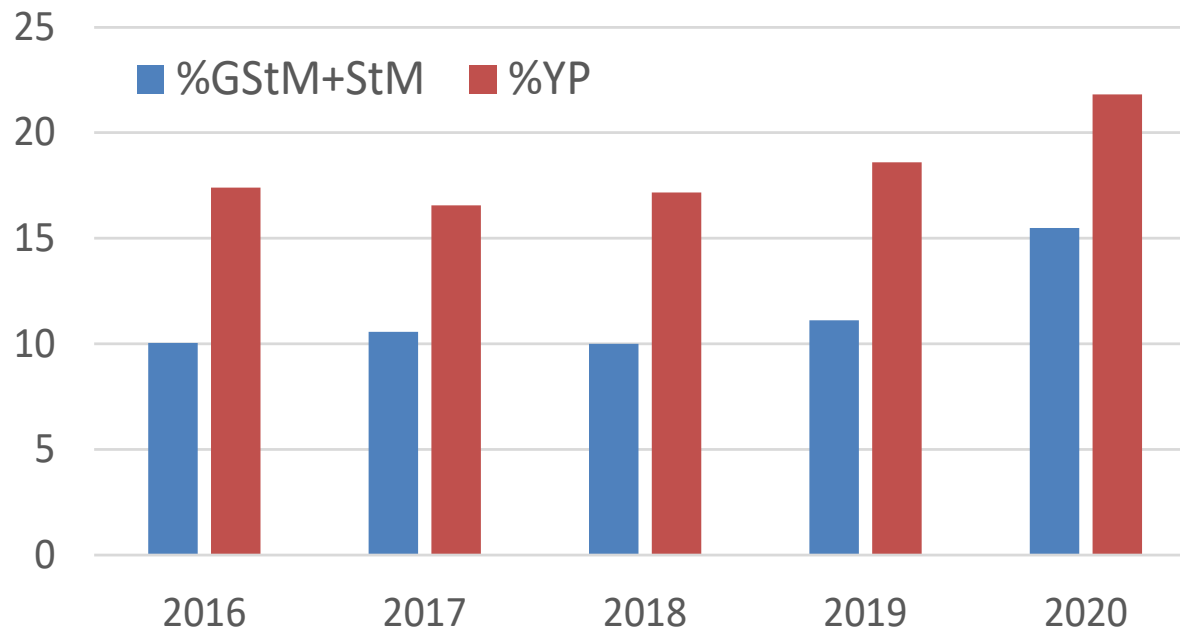

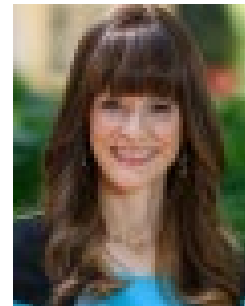

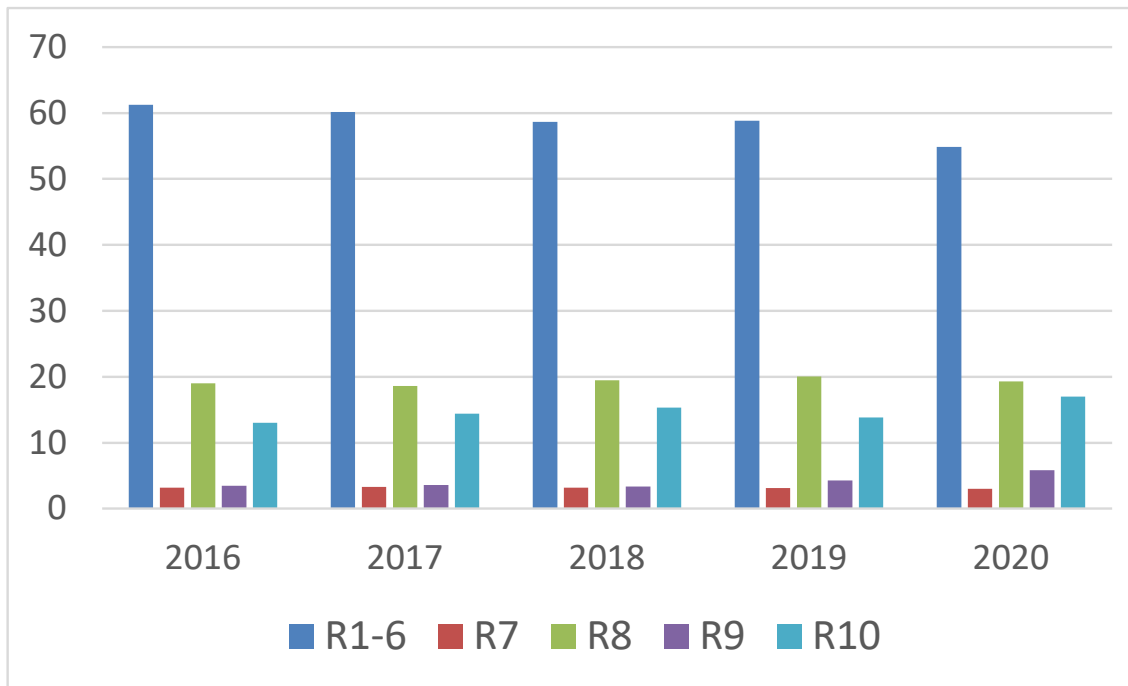

AESS Chapters

Tasks completed and activities in progress

- Revised the funding opportunities for AESS Chapters and designed clear processes to request support.



Changed the mechanism for providing regular annual support to Chapters

- Transitioned from a Society “push” to a Chapter “pull” approach.
- Created an efficient process to collect Chapter requests using a Google form.



Introduced a higher level of support (Major Initiatives)

- Requires a detailed form to be submitted.
- Budget for 2021 is \$35,000.

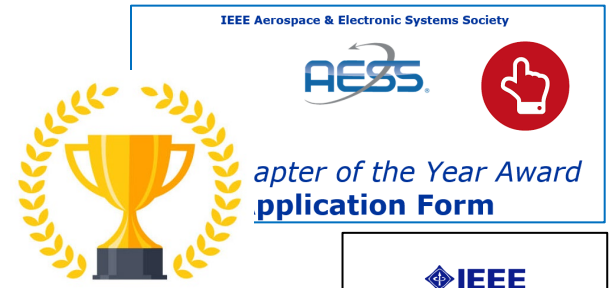
