# Finance Goals & Objectives

- 4- Report financial health to Board



# **Summary**

The Society is still solvent

we were budgeted to generate a surplus of \$294.6k in 2018

But we actually generated a surplus of \$802.2k in 2018

These numbers are final and audited

Also they are w/o investment income

BUT With IEEE investment loss of \$198.8k, our surplus was \$602.4k

We were budgeted to generate a surplus of \$184.8k in 2019 I won't see preliminary numbers until the week of Jan 21



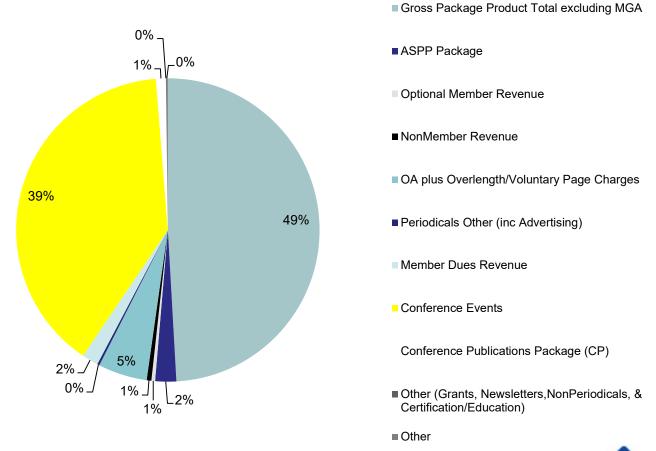

Note that the DL, Treasurer and President's travel are in the \$127k number, thereby inflating (incorrectly) the 1900 account increase. This was unknown when reported in November but confirmed once the final 2020 budgets were received, in late November,

In addition, the Chapter Support AdHoc Committee is recommending to TAB that all Societies and Councils start to budget additional Chapter support beyond the \$50 per meeting; I recommend a maximum of \$15k for our 50+ Chapters to start. The President can approve all individual requests. *Note: Motion Needed for this!* 



## One more super cool item

- Michael Wicks has generously donated \$25,000 to AES.
- We are working to see how we can create an endowment, award, or something special to do with this outstanding donation. For now it has been deposited in our GL accounts
- Michael also allows that this is not a 1-time donation; more will be forthcoming.
- I think that AES should be exceptionally proud that we have such a generous and thoughtful donor
- A special educational support account has been set up in the IEEE Foundation where the funds will continuously earn interest. We will name the fund at the Spring Board meeting and make initial decisions on the use.



## **Initiatives**

- Initiatives are activities that a Society or Council wishes to implement on a 1-time basis that would benefit IEEE and/or the Society, and IEEE encourages such.
- Since the initial 2017 budget was looking good we inserted two:
  - 1- Funding for a possible "Chapter Summit" in conjunction with Sections Congress in August 2017, Sydney Australia in the amount of \$45k
    - We subsequently abandoned that as too expensive and not cost effective
    - Agreed on a "local" Chapter Summit at an AES conference instead
  - 2- Initial funding for two Scholarships, in the amount of \$10k.

We voted to implement since AES hasn't been as prominent in our educational thrusts as many Societies.

Budget for it has been approved by IEEE

Two annual scholarships in Electrical (UG) and Systems (G) Engineering, \$5,000 for undergraduate and \$5,000 for graduate Forms submitted to IEEE and approved for implementation 2018.

Scholarship Committee of 3 established.



## **IEEE Expense Report Rules**

The IEEE Board has declared that all expense reports must be submitted with 60 days of completion of travel, or they will not be reimbursed.

 FYI this is not enforceable, but AES Board members are asked to try to submit within 60 days.
