▶ Strengths:

- Impact factor of the Magazine has grown from 0.771 to 1.594 over the past five years
- Impact factor of the Transactions has grown from 1.975 to 4.102 over the past five years
- Timeliness of TAES has improved from 83.5 to 36.8 avg weeks for submission to publication

▶ Weaknesses:

- Diversity of the Editorial Boards
- Identification of emerging areas of interest; especially related to Industry

▶ Opportunities:

- Collaborate with Industrial Relations to provide Magazine content such as interviews
- Collaborate with Technical Operations to work with Technical Panels to organize special issues/sections for the Magazine and Transactions
- Special issues in new OJSE Journal
- Coordination with Conferences?

▶ Threats:
