Conferences Strategic Objectives

 - Strengths

 - Weaknesses
 - Weak volunteer support to others: DASC, ICNS
- What are our long term strategic objectives?
 - Convert 2 TCS conferences to at least 10% FCS
 - Find ways to use conferences to attract and retain young members



Conferences Initiatives

- New volunteers on Conference committees
 - Kathleen Kramer to DASC Executive Committee
 - Mchael Braasch as PLANS Conference rep
- Radar Systems Panel Strategic Plan
 - "The RadarConf series will be held outside the US <u>not more than</u> 2 out of every 5 years, to include the 0/5 years as a non-US location with the 2/3 years available for non-US bids and the 6/7 years available for non-US bids." The 0/5 year location must:
 - 1) be voted upon by the RSP as usual
 - 2) be held in the fall
 - 3) be located in a region well-separated from the Intl. Conf. in DC
 - 4) not be in countries already visited by the Intl. Conf. series
 - 5) have sufficient support from the local radar industry
- Potential Merger of PLANS with ISISS
 - ISISS is sponsored by the Sensors Council
 - Alternate biannual conferences
 - Merged annual 50/50 conference



Conferences Metrics/Scorecard

(1) Relations with AIAA for DASC and ICNS

- Telecon last week with all parties
 - They accept that we cannot share IEL revenues
 - Recognize value of IEEE HQ services
 - But looking for more AESS participation to expand conference

(2) Eight Financially Co-sponsored Conferences

- Two more than 2013 (PLANS, MetroAerospace)
- Revenues up



Conferences Financial Assessment

- (1) Conference Surpluses are holding up well
 - First DASC in Europe presents some risk
 - IEEE policy inhibits participation as Chair, Tech Chair
- (2) We have not thought through the potential cost of supporting students and GOLD members to atend
- (3) Considered a Publications Issue, but will likely negatively affect paper submissions and attendance at our conferences
