THEY WITH THE HELP OF AESS AND RAeS MENTORS ASSEMBLE THE AIRCRAFT AND DEMONSTRATE ITS FLYING CAPABILITIES. THE FUTURE OF FLIGHT WOULD BE THE LOCAL POINT OF CONTACT.
