Strategic Analysis

- Transactions recently made a significant progress in reducing sub-to-pub delays and early posting that is almost in place will make further improvements. Newly appointed Technical Editors with term limits are in place and new Associate Editors with term-limits are in place.
- Magazine numerous initiatives are in progress and submission is readership is anticipated. Impact factor is at 0.963 already.
- Tutorials submissions to tutorials has increase due to recruiting, etc. Two tutorial issues are planned for 2017.
- QEB special efforts are being made to improve the QEB and increase readership. Opens are at 34%.
- AESS Web Site special efforts are being made to improve the quality and value to our members. 2017 page views are up slightly over 2016 page views.







Number of Submissions to T-AES






Submissions by Technical Area for T-AES






New Manuscripts Per Month in AES-M (sent for review)



 - Initial year of new agreement for integrated services
 - Continue Bi-Monthly electronic publication
 - Managing Editing, Copy Editing, Typesetting, XML tagging
- Conference Catalysts \$7,176
 - Editorial support to IEEE Pubs
- Precision Computer Works (EJP) \$15,000
 - eJournal Database
 - Includes support for Systems magazine
- Total for Budget Plan 2017: \$193,406
 - Does not include IEEE-related expenses attributed to Transactions (e.g. various purchase services, XPLORE, etc.)
 - Approx. 36% reduction in expenses from 2016 due to change in publishing vendor



T-AES Expenses-Estimated vs. Actual 2017






2017 Budget - Expenses Estimate AES Magazine

 - 2nd year of 3 year contract, includes 3% escalation
- Bright Copy On-line version \$3,400
 - Allen Press
- Administrative/Asst. Administrative Editors \$35,000
 - Susanne J. Walsh (SJW) Independent Contractor
- Total Budgeted Expenses for 2016: \$303,625
- Editorial Board move to publish more pages per issue (due to backlog)
- Allen Press submitted an invoice in August (\$6383.57) that was for the November 2016 Tutorial – because it was late, charged against this year's budget
- No invoices received from Allen Press for August as yet (they are behind publication schedule)
