
## **New Pictorial Roster**

Frank McGinnis Professional Achievement Award

Nomination Deadline 31 May 2010

The prestigious Frank McGinnis Professional Achievement Award will be presented at IEEE AUTOTESTCON 2010 in Orlando, FL on September 13-16, 2010 to the individual who best upholds the tradition of advancing the field of Automated Test. This award is named for Automated Test pioneer and Sperry employee, the late Frank McGinnis, who spearheaded a Navy (1975) and then a Joint Services (1978) Automatic Test Project to identify and recommend those areas where the military should invest in automated test research & development, and improve management practices. It resulted in the formation of the National Defense Industrial Association (NDIA) Automatic Test Committee which endures today, and which also holds one of its annual meetings in conjunction with AUTOTESTCON. 


