Expense Reporting

Business class airfare must be pre-approved by the AESS President and IEEE unless for flights over 8 hours.

Travel advances will be allowed/processed for prepaid expenses such as airfare will allowed before travel and will be shown in the final travel expense report as an advance.

Personal meals shall not exceed \$100 per day unless approved.

Travel expense reports shall follow the IEEE travel guidelines in the documents section as posted on http://www.ieee-aess.org/

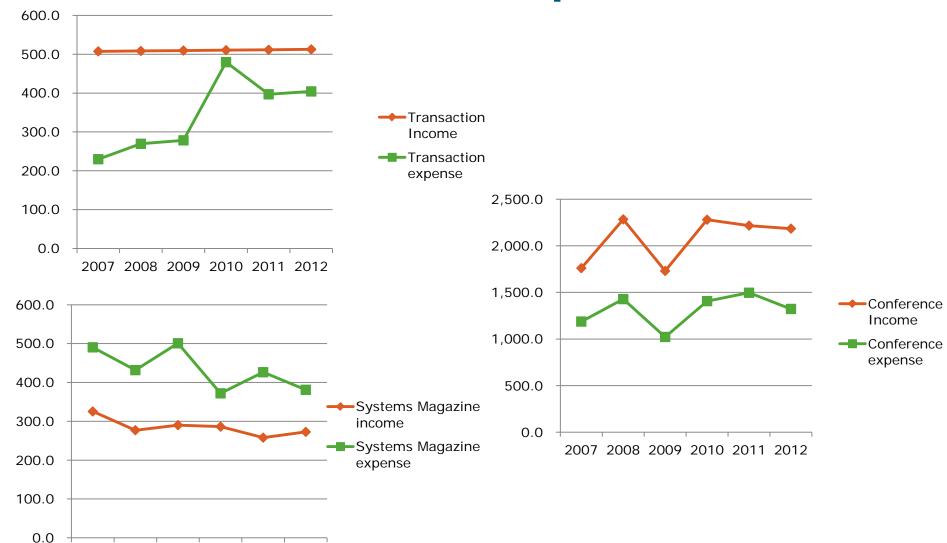


Expense Reporting

- 1. Prepare the expense report using the 2013 Microsoft EXCEL expense form and **send within 30 days!**
- 2. Scan receipts for any expense over \$25
- 3. \$US is IEEE default, therefore, if you complete in another currency, show the currency exchange rate at the lower left note section of the expense report.
- 4. Show how you would like to receive payment in your email or in the note section of the expense report.
- 5. **Include your name** in the file names to avoid mixing with other expense reports. i.e. smith expense report DL-travel.xls and add your address and IEEE member number to the form.
- 6. Send the completed expense report to me within 30 days of your travel. **Do not copy IEEE finance since this may delay payment.**

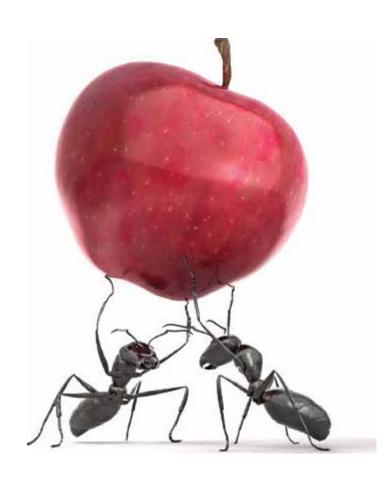
