- In Dec.1-4, 2003, the first Chinese Conference on Synthetic Aperture (CSAR 2003) was held at Hefei City, Anhui Province, China
- In Nov.2-4, 2005, the second Chinese Conference on Synthetic Aperture (CSAR 2005) was held at Nanjing, Jiangsu Province, China
