



Summary

- 1. Active Chapters are involved with industry, students and technology
- 2. Marginal Chapters have stale membership and leaders they need objectives and visits from AESS Board members and Distinguished Lecturers
- 3. Inactive Chapters have lost their way due to
 - economic conditions,
 - have less than a critical mass (< 50 members since only 20% of AESS Chapter membership attend meetings),
 - technology shifts, etc.
 - these Chapters need a *rejuvenation program* with the support of the local IEEE Section and Region.

Chapter Action Items

- IEEE AESS Membership Recruitment
 - Support new AESS Chapters
 - Encourage students chapters
 - Coordinate with new members through AESS co-sponsorship of meetings
- IEEE AESS Membership Sustainment
 - Meetings, speakers, AESS support
- Motion:
 - Approve \$10K to cover L-31 reimbursements for chapter meetings in 2011
