I am the chapter chair for the Baltimore chapter of AESS. There is a museum near Baltimore where we hold all our meetings. This museum used to be known as the Historical Electronics Museum, but is now renamed to the National Electronics Museum. AESS used to be a sponsor of this museum, offering \$1000 or so per year to help it maintain its operations. In fact, the main lecture hall/banquet room is named "Pioneer Hall" in honor of the AESS, and features posters of many past recipients of the Pioneer Award.

It seems that we have not given them any money for several years, and they are wondering if we would be willing to help out. They are currently going through a modernization in keeping with their new name and would like to rekindle their relationship with AESS.
