



Please:


- **Try to use your video feed where possible** Having the video feed helps the flow of the discussion by providing some non-verbal cues.
- **Don't be late to the call/Video** Also, keep the meeting timing in mind. Be aware of the time you take to introduce or discuss a topic and its relevance to the call.
- Consider how you present yourself on video To include attire, background, etc. If possible, seek a place with lower distractions for the duration of the call.
- Use the mute button Use the mute button when you're not talking to help keep distracting sounds to a minimum. Don't forget to unmute the phone when it's your turn to talk. When using computer audio, keyboard clicking is audible on the line.

REMOTE Meeting Ground Rules

- Introduce yourself before speaking There are a lot of people on the call, so this helps.
- **Be prepared** Prepare for a conference call like you would any other meeting.
- Try to keep a good signal Try to stay in a place where you have a good phone signal, a bad connection could cause static or make your voice beak up when you speak or may even drop the line. Try to find a quiet place to be prepared to discuss points without background noise.
- Voting protocol When asked for a voice vote, we will ask in reverse order: Abstentions, No votes, then everyone left will be a "yes" vote.
- Secret ballot election voting We will use the polling feature on the Zoom platform.



 Continually expand technically; add activities, programs, and initiatives; and enhance products and services.


