V/P International Operations and At-Large Activities (Summary)

- Eight regional Directors operating, six also hold BoG positions, and Chapter Chairs
- Only four reports submitted, including from two non-BoG Directors.
- Two Most active regions are Turkey, Pakistan and Middle East, and Ukraine and Eastern Europe.
- UK, Australia and China marginal activities towards International operations.
- Russia is inactive. Japan has no significant activity.
- Chapter formed, membership added and significant objective-related progress made only in active regions. Other regions have unknown progress in membership buildup, chapter formations, educational programs.
- V/P performing contacts with uncharted regions..

Projected activities for remaining 2007

- Organize and participate in an AESS session at HONET 2007 in Dubai
- Organize one day exchange “meeting of the mind” for regional directors to discuss and formulate “future educational, professional, and societal activities” in their regions.
- Continue Latin America focus
