- Educational events organized by the technical panels (e.g. Radar Summer School RSP).

#### Weaknesses

Decision times on awards/scholarship.

#### Opportunities

- Expand DL concept to lecture series complementary to the DSTEI initiative.
- Capitalize on experience gained organizing online educational events.
- Capitalize on experience gained organizing educational events (e.g. RSS & Radar Challenge RSP).

Necessity to change educational offerings in order to meet current demands.



### **2023 Objectives**



## Facilitate quality **in-person and online educational events** while reducing barriers to **accessing education resources**.

- 1. Expand online educational offerings
- 2. Facilitate the organization of in-person educational events within the society
- 3. Aid members in accessing educational resources



### Objective 1 - Expand online educational offerings



#### **Status:**

- A set of webinars has been organized. It was difficult to obtain recommendations for speakers and to obtain a commitment from potential speakers. Hosting webinars as virtual DLs is significantly easier.
- Continued growth of videos on ILN, from 96 in October '22 to currently 130 as of April '23.
   ILN usage as of 6<sup>th</sup> April: 2023 218 (56) total views, 2022 291 (52) total views, 2021 5 (0) total views (brackets indicate completed views).
- Online distinguished lectures are also added to Vimeo.
   Vimeo usage as of 20<sup>th</sup> April: 2023 139 per video average views, 2022 158 per video average views, 2021 51 per video average views, 5247 total views.

#### **2023 Goals:**

- Organize a set of webinars (3 have been held).
- Host at least 23 virtual distinguished lectures (4 held, a further 24 are current scheduled).
- Grow the number of videos on ILN from 96 (October '22) to 150 videos by the end of 2023.
- Run an advertising campaign to increase awareness and usage.



### Objective 2 – In-person educational events



#### **Status:**

- Boot camp is being planned for the Fusion Conference. Boot camps are being held at RadarConf
  '23, International Radar Conference, hopefully Glue Tech. I reach out to technical panels about
  new events without success.
- New set of distinguished lecturers for 2023 2024 term, 38 lecturers and more than 100 lectures on offer. It was necessary for all DLs to apply. A set of guidelines to improve consistency has been created, including basic activity requirements. Support for online distinguished lectures is mandatory for renewal.
- Radar challenge event being held as part of RadarConf.
- YP receptions being held at RadarConf '23 and Fusion '23.

#### **2023 Goals**

- Convince a different AESS conference to run a summer school (boot camp) and support its organization.
- Organize lecture series and support the DSTEI initiative.
- Increase the number of in-person DLs (goal 30).



### Objective 3 – Access to educational resources



#### **Status:**

- Robert T. Hill Best Dissertation Award had eight applicants. Quality was very high. Winner was Leonardo Millefiori from CMRE. Judging performed by the entire committee within three month time period.
- Engineering Scholarship has 16 applicants. Number of applicants significantly increased. Deadline was extended from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 31<sup>st</sup> January. No decision yet.
- YP Travel Grants are being offered for RadarConf '23, Fusion and AutotestCon.
  - RadarConf: 23 applicants and three recipients. Multiple recipients could not accept the award.
  - Fusion: 10 applicants .
  - AutotestCon: currently 7 applicants, applications close 26<sup>th</sup> June.
- Three recipients of the Michael Wicks Award for RadarConf '23.

#### **2023 Goals:**

- Send 9 AESS YPs to AESS conferences.
- Reduce the scholarship decision time to three months.
